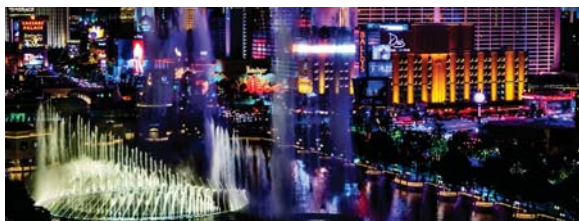

Join your colleagues and the outstanding panel of clinically active faculty members who will discuss practical strategies to improve the health, outcomes and quality of life of your chronically ill patients.

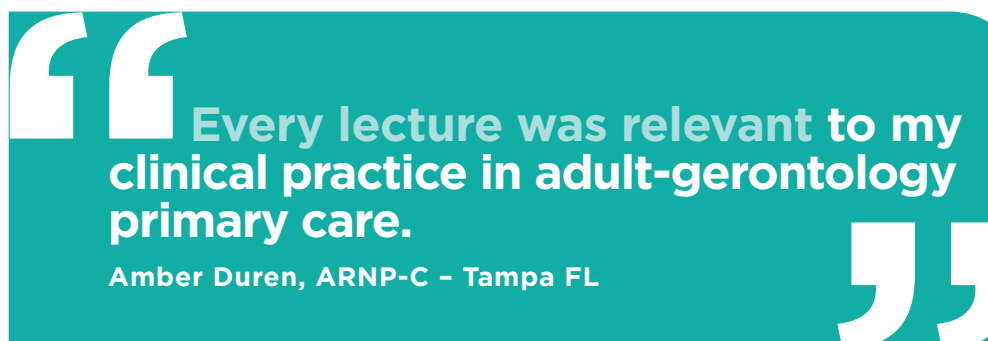
