1. Primary Care Providers (PCP's) see most patients with mental health complaints and problems. They are the frontline in mental healthcare and substance use care.
2. PCP's prescribe most antidepressant medications and are prescribing more antipsychotics, mood stabilizers, anti-anxiety and stimulant medications
3. The course will review evidence based use of psychiatric medications including drug interactions and medical co-morbidities. The course will review diagnosis and treatment of substance use disorders. Finally the course will review strategies in integrating mental healthcare into a primary care clinical setting.
