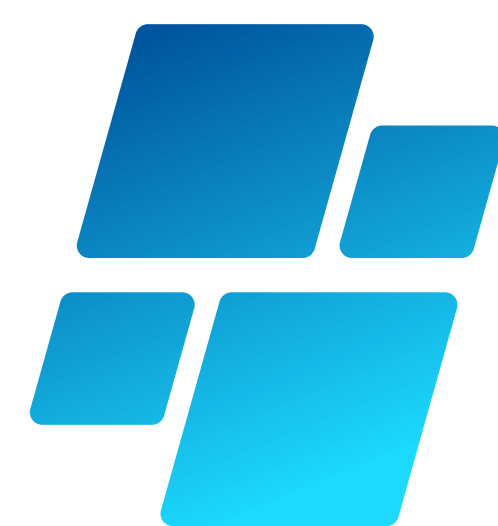
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MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIRMAN

- Building on the intent of the Global Charter for Public's Health.

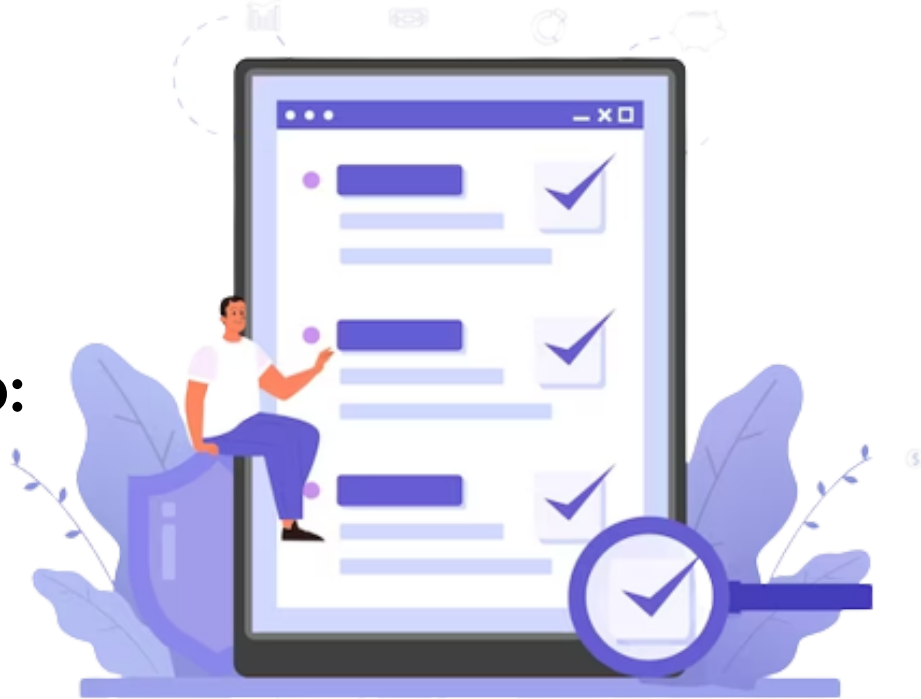
WHO SHOULD ATTEND
