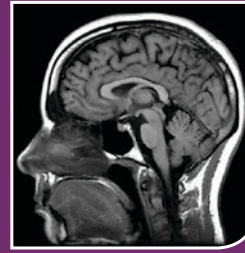

Overview

This conference is designed to educate physicians and residents in the fields of Neurology and Obstetrical Anesthesia, as well as residents, nurse practitioners, midwives, and physicians in the field of Obstetrics on issues where the fields of Neurology, Anesthesiology, and Obstetrics intersect.

Learning Objectives

The one-day-long course will feature speakers from multiple disciplines including Neurology, Obstetrics, Anesthesia, Neurosurgery, and Ethics. Subjects covered include Preeclampsia/Eclampsia, Headache Management, Epilepsy, Multiple Sclerosis, Neuro-oncology in Pregnancy, Postpartum Neuropathy, Stroke, Management of Depression and Bipolar Disease, Neurosurgical Issues in Pregnancy, Complications of Obstetrical Anesthesia, and Ethical Issues in Neurology in Pregnancy. Neurologists may earn self-assessment CME by completing an exam after the course. They will be provided correct answers, a list of references, and their score on the exam as it relates to the score earned by their peers.

Who Should Attend

This course is designed for physicians and residents in the fields of Neurology, Obstetrics, Obstetrical Anesthesia, and Family Practice, as well as midwives and nurse practitioners whose practice includes care for pregnant women.
