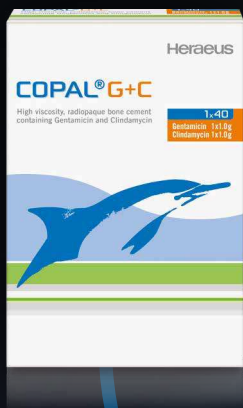

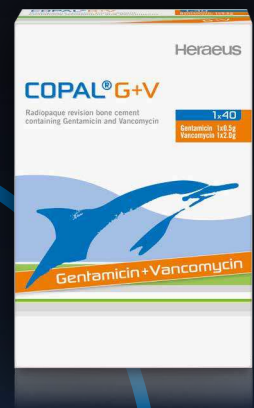

CALL FOR PAPERS

All registrars, clinicians, educators and scientists are invited to submit abstracts of their scientific research in the field of orthopaedics for consideration for an oral or poster presentation at the 2019 SAOA congress.

The closing date for submissions is 17h00 on 30th April 2019.



ABSTRACT GUIDELINES

Abstracts should be in English, no more than 350 words in length and composed as follows:

Background: State the aims of the study, the hypothesis that was tested or a description of the problem being analysed.

Methods: Provide a concise outline of the research methodology that was followed, including the study design, sample strategy, inclusion/exclusion criteria, data collection and analysis strategies that was employed.

Results: Provide a clear description of the findings.

Conclusion: Explain the significance of the main findings and the future implications of these results.

- Please avoid referring to authors, hospital, institution or city names in the abstract as these will be undergoing blinded review.
- Please do not include any figures or references in the abstract. If you have to use abbreviations, please provide the abbreviation in brackets after the first use of the full term.
- Abstracts will be reviewed and published as received. Typing and errors will not be corrected. It remains the responsibility of the authors to ensure that all information is accurate and that the language and presentation is of acceptable standard.

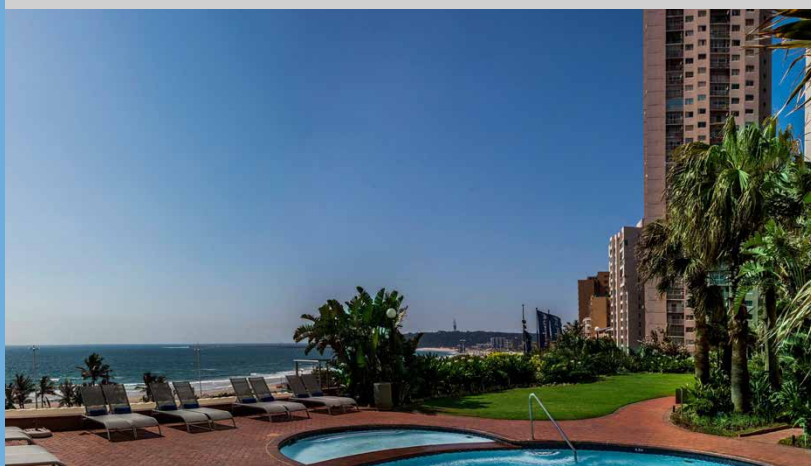

LEISURE ACTIVITIES/THINGS TO DO IN THE AREA



Built for the 2010 FIFA World Cup, the enormous stadium has many adrenaline-inducing activities on offer. The Sky Car, a single cabin that runs up steel tracks on the northern arch of the stadium and is designed to roll down the arch under its own gravity (in case of load shedding), has a 106m vantage point. Tickets cost R60 per adult and R30 for kids under the age of 12. There's also the Big Swing ride, the tallest swing in the world since 2011 (at R695 per person it exceeds our budget but is cheaper than sky-diving and looks just as nerve-wracking). Then there's a Big Sky Walk along the arch of the stadium (don't look down!) or a beach glide on a Segway for those seeking a more serene adventure. The Beach Glide costs R250 for 45 minutes.

The Durban Botanical Gardens boasts the rarest cycad collection in the world. Cycads, have been around before the dinosaurs and have survived three mass extinction events although they are in danger of extinction today. Wood's Cycad is reputed to be the world's rarest plant. You can find it growing peacefully near the old reservoir. The orchid collection and palm grove are also worth visiting. Entrance to the gardens is free. 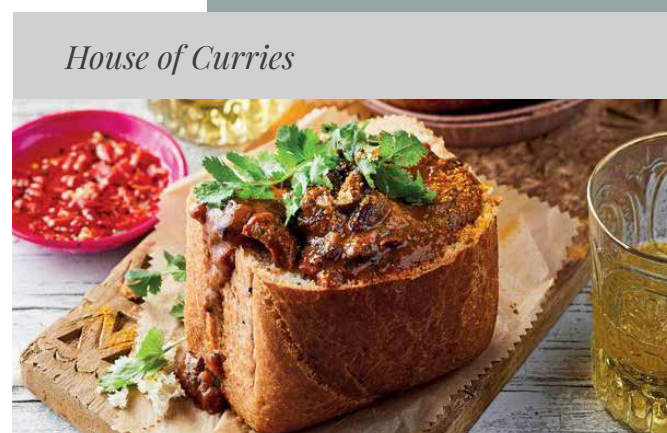

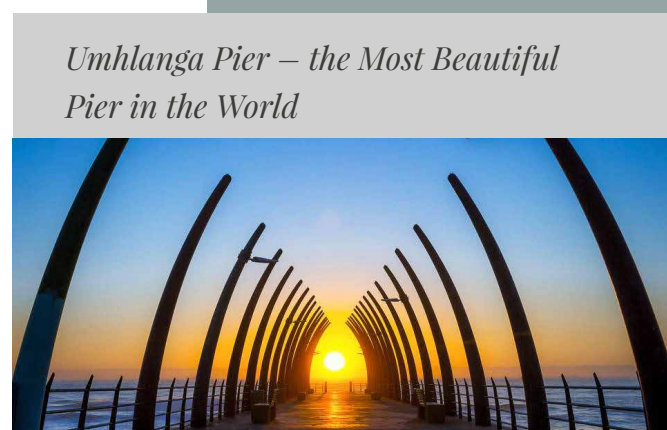
