Dear Radiologist,

The Global Hands Musculoskeletal MRI & Ultrasound Mini Fellowship Course for Radiologists will be held from April 21st to 24th 2027 at Hotel Maya, Kuala Lumpur

Here are the key features of the Global Musculoskeletal MRI and Ultrasound Mini Fellowship for Radiologists only. At the completion of this mini fellowship course your certificate will state that you have viewed 280 DICOM MRI and ultrasound cases of normal and pathology of major joints and muscle.

1. All radiologists will receive a chance to be tutored by senior Musculoskeletal Radiologists who are experts in Musculoskeletal Ultrasound. In today's MSK Radiology practice, you will find that MSK Ultrasound has taken a greater role in diagnosis of superficial tendon and ligament pathology.

4. 280 over MSK MRI and MSK Ultrasound DICOM VIDEOS covering 95% of common pathology and advanced pathology will be shown. This is what you may see in a two year Musculoskeletal Fellowship but now in 4 days. The videos have been carefully selected and tips and pearls will be shared as the videos are shown. High quality DICOM videos are now being shown during the MRI & Ultrasound video sessions to complement the lectures.

5. Focus will be on how we really solve problems in patients with MSK symptoms using one or other modality or both MSK MRI and Ultrasound. Participants will be taught which modality is better for which indication for accuracy of diagnosis. For example, it is far more accurate to use ultrasound for detection of ankle tendon and ligament tears than MRI as these structures are very small on MRI and often not clearly visualised in the 3mm slices but seen very well on ultrasound and function can be tested with dynamic manoeuvres. Emphasis will be on how to grade residual function of a ligament which is what the Orthopaedic surgeon wants to know and also tendon pathology.

6. For the practical sessions, you will have a choice to be trained at Basic, Intermediate or Advanced Level. Basic level means you have not attended any Basic MSK Ultrasound course and are not doing MSK USS weekly. Intermediate level means you have attended a Basic MSK Ultrasound Course and are practising MSK ultrasound weekly on patients. Advanced level means you are highly experienced in MSK Ultrasound and would request more specific teaching of different joints and joint procedures.

7. We will provide each participant with a USB which will contain about 8GB of data. Articles on all the major joint pathology, reporting templates, MRI sequence protocols, Videos, Powerpoints, E-books, etc. Most of this material has been donated by previous lecturers and my fellows over the years. It has some of the best references to articles on particular topics over the last 10 years and forms part of the curriculum. Learning indeed continues well after the course until you have read all the articles provided.

8. The course enables a radiologist to report MSK MRI accurately for all common pathology as it concentrates on reporting of 95% of common pathology well. Think about it, what is the point of knowing the course of the sural nerve when you can't even report ACL tears accurately? At the end of the course, one can also perform basic MSK Ultrasound well and make diagnosis of main and common pathology of most joints. MSK Ultrasound often identifies the real cause of the patients' current symptoms rather than MRI which may be non-specific myriad of new or old abnormalities.

9. On the final day, I will be introducing a new addition to the course programme. I look forward to sharing about my current experience and knowledge with Interventional joint injections from working as a Consultant Radiologist at Beverly Wilshire. Explanation of injectables especially PRP and how they work, indications, techniques in detail of injection will be the focus of the final day. 11. Opportunities for 4 oral paper presentations (8 min each) are available. Kindly submit your standard abstract (not more than 250 words) to the Secretariat for consideration by the Scientific Committee. Further details will be provided following your submission. The topics must be by musculoskeletal.

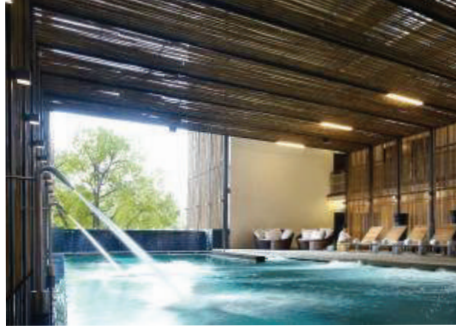

Buying refundable or partially refundable air tickets is advised. The conference hotel booking can be cancelled without any payment up to one week before the event.
3. Refund will be offered if cancelled before 60 days only. There is an admin fee of USD 150 (for Malaysian RM600) plus cost of sending refund if cancelled 60 days before the course. If less than 60 days, no refund is possible as it is difficult to find a replacement. However, you can transfer to a colleague or credit transfer once to the following year. Administrative fees, printing costs and deposits already paid on your behalf will be deducted if we offer a credit transfer. You will be advised of the amount. The credit will be then transferred towards the next years registration fee which may be increased.
4. Registration transfers are allowed before the 60 day cancellation period. No additional fees will be imposed for registration transfers.
5. The course fee is inclusive of Halal morning and evening teas and a buffet lunch.
6. For overseas delegates, the preferred payment method is using Transfer WISE or similar for the registration fee ensuring you pay the charges for the transfer.
