The Global Burden of Disease (GBD) Study has produced sub-national estimates for a variety of injuries in India under the India State-Level Burden Initiative, a collaboration between a large number of stakeholders including Indian government institutions. This presentation will use examples of GBD estimates on suicide deaths and road traffic injuries in India to describe how these data were utilised for action, and the barriers and facilitators to this utilisation, in order to highlight how these estimates started conversations on the availability and adequacy of the national administrative data on injuries, and the lessons learnt to make injuries more visible to policy makers to save lives. The presentation will also highlight the intricacies of using big data on injuries to gain attention of policy makers for action in comparison with some other diseases in developing country settings.
