The Hartford Consensus, in collaboration with the American College of Surgeons (ACS), emphasizes that no one should die from uncontrolled bleeding. The Hartford Consensus was a group of medical, government, and military personnel that was convened in Hartford, CT, after the tragedy in Sandy Hook in 2012. Bleeding Control Basic represents the collaboration among the Hartford Consensus, the American College of Surgeons' Committee on Trauma, the Committee on Tactical Combat Casualty Care, and the National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians. Bleeding Control Basic will teach people how to use tourniquets and compression bandages to stop life threatening bleeding.
