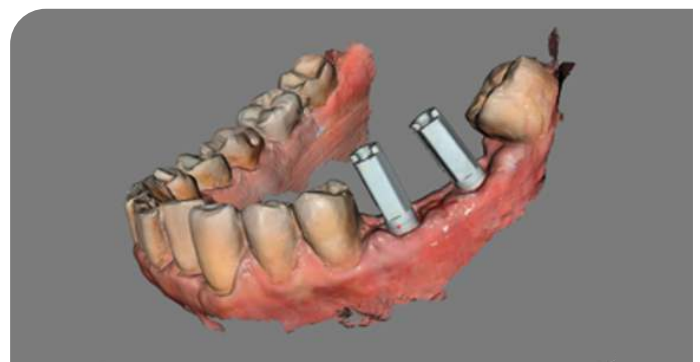

Suggested Tours

Casablanca Tour

Start the visit from the port and the old city area where you will visit the impressive Hassan II mosque to discover one of the most interesting architectural achievements in modern Morocco before you are taken to explore some of the main streets down town that date back to the French protectorate. The buildings here are made in the art-deco style, built and designed back in 1920's.

Visit Le "Marché Central", the French food and flower market, before you stop on Mohamed V square, one of the main squares of Casablanca, to admire the neo-Moorish style architecture of several official buildings such as the town hall and the court of justice built in 1930's.

Visit the largest church in Casablanca, "Notre Dame De Lourdes", where you will discover one of the most impressive works in stained glass accomplished by a French artist in the mid 1950's.

Rabat

Rabat is the capital of the Kingdom of Morocco and the residence of the King. An ancient walled city of parks and flowers, Rabat combines beauty and serenity, and it is steeped in history. Waves of immigrations brought different civilizations to this place, of Romans, Carthaginians, and Phoenician to Muslims and artifacts from these periods are on display at the Archaeology. The city itself is built next to ancient Roman ruins which you will visit in the Kasbah of Chellah, an archaeological site where you will discover the remains of two civilizations: Sala Colonia dating back to Roman times and the Merinides necropolis of the 14th century.

The main gate of Bab Errouah made in the 12th century, the Kasbah Oudaia which was occupied by Muslims evicted from Spain in the 17th century, is a beautiful example of true Moorish design. Within the walls of the Kasbah we'll explore a delightful jewelry museum and an Andalusian garden, a part of the royal residence of the 17th century. Continue to the Tour Hassan, the last vestige of an unfinished mosque of the late 12th century. Next you will admire the Mohammed V Mausoleum which is a place of exquisite contemplation. This is one of the finest architectural monuments in Morocco built as a memorial to this symbolic king of Morocco.

End your visit with a stroll in the park of the official royal palace where you will see the royal guards at the entrance of the residence.

El Jadida

Leave Casablanca and drive to El Jadida across the Chaouia and the Doukkala tribal lands where you will see lots of agricultural activities. Stop for a break and a short visit of the fortified town of Azemmour which was once a meeting point between the local coming from inland and the Portuguese traders established here from the early 16th century. Then continue to El Jadida, visit the Old Portuguese fort. El Jadida used to be a Portuguese trading harbor in the 16th century better known as Mazagan. You will be taken inside the Portuguese fort to see some remains such as the Portuguese church, the amazing water reservoir and its beautiful architecture where Orson Welles shot his film OTHELLO. Walk up the city walls for a magnificent view over the city and the port where there are still some old defense canons.

Marrakech - The Imperial City

Leave Casablanca at 08h00am and head via the motorway to the Red city of Marrakech, Today will be devoted to the discovery of this imperial city and its rich monuments such as the Koutoubia minaret, a symbol for the city since 800 years, the Bahia palace with its lovely courtyards and late Moorish architecture, the Saadian tombs with the sumptuous royal pavilion.

In the afternoon, you will be taken to visit the "Hidden sides of Marrakech" where you will discover the oldest building in the city dating back to the 12th century as well as the artisan quarters and the colourful Souks to interact with the real life of Marrakech.

Before sunset you will be strolling in the square of which the city is so famed: Jemaa El Fna where hundreds of locals and tourists come to spend the end of the day watching jugglers, dancers, fortune tellers, story tellers and traditional musicians.
