Biography

Steph hails from Montana and is a graduate of the University of Minnesota School of Dentistry. After a short stint as a general dentist in Portland, Oregon, Steph traveled to New York and completed her pathology training at the largest oral and maxillofacial pathology biopsy service in the country: New York Hospital of Queens. Prior to joining Atlanta Oral Pathology Steph returned to her alma mater in Minnesota where she was a faculty member in the School of Dentistry. Steph participated in an active biopsy service and was Director of the Oral Pathology Patient Clinic. Steph lectures to dental groups nationally on her specialty. Fulfilling a much-needed service, Steph has a clinical practice treating patients with oral mucosal diseases and difficult oral pathology at the Oro-Facial Center.

Course Objectives

Oral pathology is not an exact science. In order to achieve a proper diagnosis and subsequent treatment plan communication between clinicians and the oral pathologist is vital. In this lecture we will take a look at difficult oral pathology cases which were solved not only by what was seen under the microscope but also by corroborating with the surgeon, other health care professionals and the use of diagnostic tools to arrive at a definitive diagnosis. Selecting the proper treatment protocol rests heavily on correct interpretation of the pathology report. The talk will focus on mucosal and connective tissue lesions with an in-depth conversation on reading pathology reports and selecting treatment plans for lesions affecting these areas. A discussion on what happens behind the scenes in the laboratory will also be addressed. In addition, how pathologists are using immunohistochemistry and molecular studies to further classify lesions and the changing landscape of pathology and treatment of diseases will be discussed.
