CONTACT HOURS: FLORIDA PHARMACY ASSOCIATION IS OFFERING UP TO 22 CONTACT HOURS DURING CONVENTION. EACH COURSE IDENTIFIES THE AMOUNT OF CREDIT WHICH CAN BE RECEIVED. A TOTAL OF 18 CONTACT HOURS MAY BE OBTAINED FROM THURSDAY THROUGH SUNDAY FOR GENERAL (GCE) OR TECHNICIAN (TECH) CONTINUING EDUCATION. REDUCING MEDICATION ERRORS, AND THE VALIDATION AND COUNSELING OF PRESCRIPTIONS FOR CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ARE FLORIDA BOARD APPROVED COURSES. THE RC COURSES ARE OFFERED ON FRIDAY, AND SATURDAY. THERE ARE 6 RC HOURS ON FRIDAY AND 6 RC HOURS ON SATURDAY. FLORIDA BOARD OF PHARMACY CONSULTANT APPROVAL NUMBER IS PENDING.
